

Fall Craft Activities

This printable includes two fun fall crafts for you to complete, and a word scramble puzzle. There is a paper plate leaf wreath and a yarn-wrapped apple. You will need to gather leaves, scissors, glue, a paper plate, cardboard, and yarn. Enjoy!

Leaf Wreath Craft

1. Gather pretty leaves at the Farm Museum, the park, or in your backyard.
2. Use scissors to cut the middle out of a paper plate. Have an adult help if needed. (See left picture below.)
3. Glue your leaves around the paper plate circle to make a wreath.
4. Hang your wreath on your front door or in your home for decoration.



Yarn-Wrapped Apple Craft

1. Draw an apple shape onto a piece of cardboard (an old cereal or cracker box would be perfect). Cut it out.
2. Tape or glue one end of the yarn onto the back of your cardboard apple.
3. Wrap the yarn all around the cardboard apple making sure to cover different areas each time. (To make this step easier, you can cut little notches around the apple for the yarn to sit in as you wrap it.)
4. When you have finished wrapping your yarn, tape or glue the end onto the back of the cardboard.
5. Gather a small stick from the park, or your yard. Glue the stick onto the top of your apple to be the stem.
6. Cut out and glue a green leaf on top of your stem.
