

## Welcome to the ArborScope™ Tree Tour!

Starting in 1959, the Rotary Club has annually recognized a citizen of Carroll County whose life and career have demonstrated exemplary service to the community. Along with a donation to the honoree's charity of choice, a tree is planted, in partnership with Bartlett Tree Experts, at the Carroll County Farm Museum. There are now more than sixty commemorative trees planted on the Farm Museum grounds.

Take a tour through Carroll County's history and nature with our Arborscope™ QR codes—each Citizen of the Year Tree is tagged with their own individual QR code plaque.

### How to use a QR code:

1. Open your smartphone's camera app.
2. Focus the camera on the QR code so it is clearly visible in your smartphone screen.
3. Tap the notification that appears or follow the instructions on the screen to complete action.
4. Your smartphone will navigate to the intended destination.

Citizen of the Year trees are not planted in numerical order. You can scan or rescan QR codes for individual trees at any time and in any order. Or navigate by using the "Jump to Tree ID" application on the website.
